



# Elinor Rosenberg Breman ASYO Fellowship

## QUALIFICATION & SELECTION CRITERIA

- ◆ The Elinor Rosenberg Breman ASYO Fellowship is open to all musicians who qualify for acceptance into the ASYO.
- ◆ Applications will be available upon request following announcement of the ASYO season roster.
- ◆ The primary criterion for qualification for the fellowship is demonstrating financial need. Students must obtain permission to apply from a parent or guardian. The parent/guardian must agree to provide the ASO Learning Community's Director of Student Musician Development with a confidential copy of the family's prior-year Federal Tax return to demonstrate financial need.
- ◆ Financial need will be determined by the highest and lowest annual household incomes of the fellowship applicants each year.
- ◆ The ASO will evaluate applicants and make up to five awards providing tuition for coming season.
- ◆ Applications will include the following: detailed information on the student (age, instrument, years of play, musical experience, etc.) and a signed letter giving permission to apply from parent/guardian with a confidential copy of the family's prior-year Federal Tax return.
- ◆ Interviews may be requested when more clarity of need is needed. All applications and all interviews are handled in a confidential manner.
- ◆ The ASO reserves the right to withdraw a scholarship should the musician fail to practice their music sufficiently and attend practices and performances.
