ASO's Commitment to Education

With 28 GRAMMY® Awards under its belt, the Atlanta Symphony Orchestra and Chorus continues to build on their foundation of artistic excellence, while upholding their legacy as a cornerstone for artistic development in the Southeast. Our world-class musicians perform many educational and community concerts for the general public, but also provide more direct educational opportunities for music educators and students throughout the country.

Through masterclasses and clinics, music educators have the support of professional musicians who help to craft performance details and develop musicianship, not only for the solo musician, but for ensembles and music programs across the board.

Available Opportunities for Student Groups

Masterclass – The audience observes as a member of the Atlanta Symphony Orchestra critiques a piece prepared by a student musician. The instructor helps the student to refine technique, interpretation and performance (as if they are in a 1-on-1 lesson!). The *masterclass* has educational benefits for the group as well, as the instructor shares general knowledge about performance practice, the composer, and other anecdotes.

Fee: \$500 for up to 2 hours with 1 ASO musician (*For **each additional** ASO musician, there is an added fee of \$250)

Clinic: There are some factors that distinguish the *masterclass* and the *clinic*. The former focuses primarily on the solo musician, while the latter is designed for the instructor to critique a prepared piece by a **musical ensemble**. *Please note, the *clinic* requires the **ensemble director** to conduct the piece.

Fee: (for up to 2 hours with 1 ASO musician)

- \$500 (50-100 students)
- \$750 (101-120 students)
